

# Stop Linton Wind Farm



## Great News

The Development Control Committee of Uttlesford District Council, under the Chairship of Mrs Jackie Cheetham, met last week to determine the application for one turbine which Enertrag UK Ltd has submitted as part of Linton Wind Farm development. Six members of the SLWF group gave short reports covering renewable energy, noise, landscape and amenity, the potential impact on the breeding programmes at Linton Zoo, health and the A1307 and on inefficiency. Two District Councillors (Julie Redfern, The Chesterfords, and Rod Chamberlain, Hadstock, Ashdon & Swards End), and the Chairman of Great Chesterford Parish Council (Peter Fentem) also spoke against the application. Enertrag, FoE and a local environmental group all spoke in favour.

We are delighted to say that 10 members of the Committee voted against the application, two were in favour and two abstained.

It is expected that Enertrag will now appeal against this decision.

South Cambridgeshire District Council has yet to meet, but we understand that further information has been requested of Enertrag.

This is excellent news, but unfortunately it is not over ... yet.
